



Brockenhurst College offers subsidised college bus passes with further discounts available to purchasers of our Early Bird (full academic year) and termly passes. For greater flexibility, all our digital passes include evening and weekend use of key BlueStar, MoreBus & SalisburyReds public bus services.

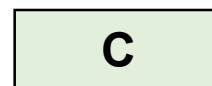
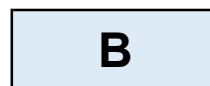
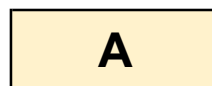
Learners eligible for financial support receive up to a 100% bursary contribution when purchasing a period pass.

2025/26 pricing is zoned with immediately local bus stops (e.g. Lymington & Lyndhurst) falling within Zone A. Stops in the wider Totton & Waterside area and those along the south coast from Burton through Everton fall within Zone B. Stops in Salisbury, Bournemouth, Southampton and the wider Ringwood area fall within Zone C. Not all areas served by our extensive college bus network are listed below, please email for bespoke travel guidance from your area.

Our termly passes offer a minimum 12.5% discount vs the equivalent period passes and will remain available for purchase via our online store at the standard rate (always sold on a full term basis) for the first month of their respective periods of validity.

Our period passes are typically valid from the second teaching day of the month to the first teaching day of the following month (e.g. 02/10/2025 - 03/11/2025 for the October pass). The final month of each term may differ - e.g. the December pass expires 19/12/2025 and the January pass is valid from 05/01/26. Typically, purchase on the last working day of the previous month is recommended - e.g. payment for the October pass (valid from Thursday 02/10/25) is recommended Tuesday 30/09/25 (the September pass includes passage Wednesday 01/10/25).

PURCHASING A 2025/26 BUS PASS - OUR ONLINE COLLEGE STORE

All college bus passes are purchased via our online college store. Payments for course resources, trips & activities, stationery & art supplies, course uniform, textbooks and many more items are also made via our online store. This includes where using bursary funds are to be used as the payment method (e.g. bursary purses).

Please register for a store account at <https://brock.collegestore.uk/> and then follow the on screen instructions to link your student/applicant record. To link your student record and complete registration, the store will email a unique code to the student/applicant. Please ensure the college holds your most up to date email address.

Our bus pass products are only available for purchase by college store accounts with a linked student record. If you skip the above step during account creation, you will need to select 'LINKED STUDENTS' within 'My Account' to retrospectively complete the registration and establish the student link. Student records can be linked to multiple college store accounts if desired - e.g. one store account created using a college email address, and another using that of a parent or guardian.

Within **Browse Categories**, please select **Bus Passes** and then **Zone A, B or C** (as per the table on the reverse). The 2025/26 Early Bird, Autumn term and September 2025 period products will be visible from 12/08/2025, with October-onward, Spring and Summer term passes published throughout the year.

2025/26 bus timetables and our updated route map can be found on the Travel page of the College website and multiple bus services (e.g. C4 & C12) and locations (within the same zone) can be added to a pass at checkout. The higher zone rate is typically payable for a multi-zone pass, please email travel@brock.ac.uk to confirm.

FULL ACADEMIC YEAR PASSES - 25% EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT - AVAILABLE UNTIL 07/09/2025 ONLY

Our Early Bird bus passes are sold on a full year basis. This single payment option affords a c. 25% discount vs the cumulative period charges for the academic year and offers the maximum level of public service use (i.e. includes the winter and spring breaks - please see below).

Early Bird passes are offered exclusively via the college's online store and will be **available for online purchase until 10:59 pm on Sunday 07/09/2025 ONLY**.

Early Bird passes are refundable in full where an applicant does not join us in September and the payment deadline falls after the release of 2025/26 academic timetables. Early Bird purchases are otherwise non-refundable excepting withdrawal from Brockenhurst - refunds processed in line with usage and the full, equivalent, termly and/or period charges apply - e.g. for a February 2026 withdrawal, the refund would reflect the full charge for the Autumn term plus January and February 2026 period passes.

TERMLY PASSES

Our Autumn, Spring & Summer term passes offer a minimum 12.5% discount vs the cumulative charges for the equivalent period and are sold on a full-term basis with no commitment to purchase a pass for subsequent terms. Autumn term passes are refundable in full where an applicant does not join us in September.

Please note that passes do not automatically renew each term and are non-refundable excepting withdrawal from College. Refunds following withdrawal are processed in line with usage and full period pass charges apply - e.g. for a withdrawal at any point during November 2025, the September, October and November charges would apply in full.

PERIOD PASSES

Our period passes offer the flexibility to purchase travel on a monthly basis and can be combined with termly passes where desired - e.g. where a bus user is intending to drive from February 2026, the Autumn 2025 term and January 2026 period passes could be combined to maximise the available discount. Period passes do not automatically renew and are sold as a standalone products with no commitment to purchase passes for subsequent periods / to have previously held a college bus pass.

All period passes within a zone are priced at the same, fixed rate - e.g. £95 per period for Zone B passes - **and are typically valid from the second teaching day of a calendar month to the first teaching day of the following month.** Barring non-enrolment in September 2025, period passes are non-refundable once used on a college or public bus; please refer to individual store products for full terms and conditions.

Purchase on the last working day of the previous month is recommended - e.g. payment for the October pass (valid from Thursday 02/10/2025) is recommended Tuesday 30/09/2025. Please note that pass generation is not an automated process - passes are typically generated at 04:00 pm on the day of purchase / 04:00 pm the next working day where purchased evenings or weekends. One-day grace periods will be in effect 05/01/2026 and 13/04/2026 to reflect college closure the working day prior.

BURSARY SUPPORT with TRAVEL COSTS

Learners eligible for the 2025/26 Discretionary Bursary receive a 75% discount when purchasing PERIOD bus passes (e.g. Zone B is reduced to £23.75 p/pass). To qualify for the Discretionary Bursary, the take-home pay for the household must be less than £35k per annum (nett pay, excluding any benefit payments). Ongoing bursary support is linked to attendance - advance discounts cannot be applied to termly or full year college bus passes however, attendance-linked, weekly refunds can be requested in respect of both pass types.

Where a 2025/26 bursary has been awarded, our online store will automatically apply the discount to September 2025 products at checkout. Discounts will continue to automatically apply to all subsequent 2025/26 period passes (purchase required, see payment dates on reverse) providing attendance and course commitment criteria are met. Learners eligible for the Vulnerable Bursary who request a college bus pass will see a 100% discount (i.e. no charge) applied to September-onward products at checkout.

PUBLIC SERVICE USE - BLUESTAR, MOREBUS & SALISBURY REDS

Go South Coast provide the Brockenhurst College bus services and offer purchasers of a college bus pass the flexibility of travelling free of charge on their BlueStar 6, 8 & 9, SalisburyReds X3 and MoreBus X1, X2 & X6 public services. Brockenhurst College does **not** sell passes for use exclusively on public services.

Unrestricted use - including daytime, evenings, weekends, the winter/spring breaks and all reading weeks - of the above public services is available 08/09/2025 through 08/07/2025 to purchasers of the 2025/26 Early Bird pass. Termly passes are valid on these public services during reading weeks (e.g. unrestricted use 08/09/2025 through 19/12/2025 for the Autumn term pass) but do not include the winter or spring breaks.

Period passes are also valid on the above public services, please note however the validity may not extend for a full calendar month - e.g. the March 2026 pass is valid 03/03/2026 - 27/03/2026 and the April 2026 pass is valid 13/04/2025 - 01/05/2025. Neither pass is valid during the 28/03/2025 - 12/04/2025 college closure.

DIGITAL BUS PASSES - THE MOREBUS APP

All college bus passes are issued as digital tickets via the MoreBus app. The app displays both pass validity and a countdown to the ticket expiration date.

Early Bird, Autumn Term & September 2025 purchasers will receive an email from MoreBus on 03/09/2025 (subject to purchase 02/09/2025 or earlier) containing download instructions for their app and a unique bus pass activation code. From 08/09/2025, activation codes will typically be generated and sent in advance of the following working day.

SINGLE & RETURN FARES

For ad hoc passage, single and return fares (cash and contactless payment accepted) are available from the drivers of the college buses. There is no charge to rail users travelling on the C27 bus from Totton rail station to our Marchwood campus. External bus tickets (e.g. public network passes, tickets purchased on public buses, etc.) are **not** valid for travel on Brockenhurst services and the college does not currently offer a weekly ticket.
