Welcome to Graphics and Illustration. In preparation for the start of the course, please complete these tasks and have them with you to hand in during your first week of college in September.

These tasks should take you approximately four and a half hours to complete and are designed to give you an introduction to the subject, and the expectations we have for you to complete at least four and a half hours of independent study, per subject, per week.

Task 1 – Reflection

1. The return of light or sound waves from a surface
2. An image produced by or as if by a mirror
3. Something that brings blame or disgrace. It's a reflection of honesty.
4. Careful thought. 'After much reflection, I agreed.'
5. An opinion formed, or a remark made after careful consideration

Consider one of the definitions above for reflection and focus on an artistic response to it:

- This could be several thought-provoking photographs
- This could be an illustration drawn, painted or collaged in your medium of choice.
- This could be a computer aided design response; a vector illustration or photomanipulation using software such as Adobe, apps like Procreate or other software.

There is no wrong outcome here. We want to see your creative ideas, thought processes, techniques, skills and visual responses to get an idea of your personal style.

Please include a short paragraph discussing your chosen definition, how your work responds to this theme, what you did, and what media and techniques you used.

You will be asked to submit this either online or by hand at the end of the first week.



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
