91.1	WELCOME, APOLOGIES AND DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting. Apologies had been received from Xing Li-Bloodworth and co-opted member Tom Weeks.	
	No member declared any conflict of interest with the agenda.	
91.2	COMMITTEE BUSINESS	
91.2.1	<b>Minutes of the meeting held on 7, October 2021</b> The minutes of the meeting held on 7, October 2021 having been previously circulated to members were agreed as a true record and would be signed electronically by the Chair. <b>All Members were agreed.</b>

91.3	EQUAL OPPORTUNTIES	
91.3.1	Equal Opportunities Key Performance Indicators (KPI's) This item was presented by the Assistant Principal, Director of Learning and Quality. Members noted the report demonstrating the College's commitment to actively promoting equality of opportunity by analysing the performance of learners by learner group to identify any potential	
	gaps. It was noted that the overall College achievement rate in 2020/2021 was 90.4% against which group performance was compared. For the 16-18 cohort the College achievement rate in 2020/2021 was 81.5% compared to 80.8% in the previous year and for 19+ learners the	

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	College achievement rate in 2020/2021 was 96.9% compared to 95.5% in the previous year.	
	The Assistant Principal informed members there were no significant differences in the achievement rates of 16-18 year olds with regard to ethnicity and although there was a diverse range of ethnicities at the College, those proportions were very small and it was therefore difficult to draw conclusions.	
	In the area of learning difficulty and disability, 44% of learners in the 16-18 category had reported having a learning difficulty or disability, and the achievement rate was 80.3% compared with the College's 16-18 achievement rate of 82%.	
	With regard to gender in the 16-18 group 48% of learners identified as female and 52% identified as male.	
	In relation to Looked After Children (LAC) there was no national achievement rate data. It was noted that at the College less than 1% of 16-18 learners were identified as 'looked after'.	
	Care Leavers research showed that on average they had significantly poorer educational and life outcomes than the general population.	
	At the College Care Leavers made up less than 1% of the 16-18 student cohort.	
	Finally, it was noted that 4% of the 16-18 student population was on an Education and Health Care Plan (EHCP) and that in 2021 the achievement rate in that area was 71.1%.	
	The Assistant Principal explained the next steps plan to be put in place on how to improve particularly in the areas of Looked After Children, EHCP and High Needs students, and to identify best practice elsewhere.	
	The Chair thanked the Assistant Principal for her comprehensive report which was noted.
