What today looks like...

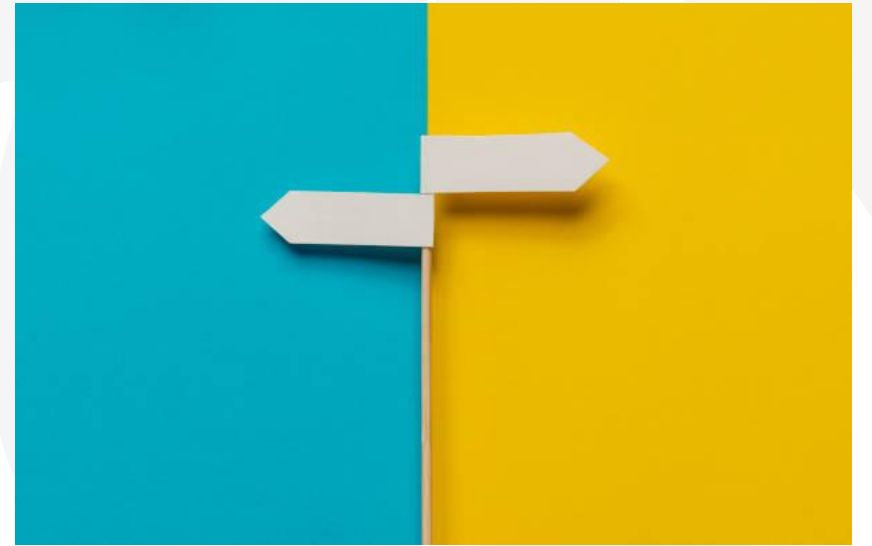
- Your subject lessons start at **09:30**
